


Steve Broyles bags the Canada Cup



Steve Broyles, of Stevenson's Cycles from Wayne, Michigan, took home top honors at Canada's International Motorcycle Supershow 2009, held January 2 - 4, at the International Centre in Toronto. Broyles entered his GL Special in the Pro Builders Class and won first place. For that he was handed \$12,000 in cash along with a 6-foot trophy. Not since 1996 has a U.S. bike won the competition to claim the Canada Cup.

It's not over: Broyles also took 3rd place in Pro Builders with his entry named Duce's Wild for an additional \$3,500 in cash! "This is one of the best shows I've entered. As it was my first time in a Canadian show, I was thrilled to be chosen as I was among a lot of great pro builders that had entered. I am really looking forward to coming back next year," stated Broyles.
