

SPS build **Destination Duo** motorcycles

IN an exclusive deal with Bruce Rossmeyer's Destination Daytona, Sucker Punch Sally's will build a limited edition run of Destination Duo motorcycles. The new bike is being built to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the first fully suspended American motorcycle - the Harley-Davidson FL Duo-Glide.

Just 50 of the Destination Duo motorcycles will be built, each featuring a reproduction



Panhead motor, five-speed kicker transmission (with an electric starter), original style 2-into-2 exhaust, optional buddy seat, and choice of a Springer or hydraulic front-end.

"We're excited to partner with Sucker Punch Sally's on this bike," said Bruce Rossmeyer, owner of Destination Daytona. "We wanted a bike that had a vintage feel and lived up to the demands of today's riders. Who better to bring a classic back to life than the old-school experts themselves -Sucker Punch Sally's."

The first Destination Duo bike with "serial number one" was auctioned off during Sturgis Bike Week 2008. Each of the limited edition bikes will have a commemorative serial number, a numbered motor, a numbered, functional custom leather pogo seat and a limited edition print by renowned hotrod artist Sara Ray.
