Fifty limited-edition Destination Duo models will be available through Rossmeyer's Destination Daytona. Each will feature a commemorative serial number; a numbered motor; a numbered, functional leather pogo seat, and a limited-edition print from renowned hot-rod artist Sara Ray.



SPS has also entered into a partnership with Spectro Oils that will see the company become an authorized Spectro distributor and name Spectro as its brand of choice for all motorcycle lubricant needs.
