Cigar Maker Teams Up With Custom Bike Builder For Year-Long Tour And Giveaway

CAO, one of the world's foremost premium cigar manufacturers, announced today that it is partnering with custom bike builder Sucker Punch Sally's (SPS) to create a truly one-of-a-kind custom CAO-inspired bike. The bike will tour the United States and ultimately be given away to a lucky winner.
